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Membership Categories and Fees 2020

A 'sailor' is categorized as a person who has a disability.

Adult Sailor £40
An adult over 18 years who would like to take part in Sailability events.

Family Sailor £60
A family who would like to take part in Sailability events who have at least one member of the family residing at the same address with a disability.

Volunteer £5
An adult, young person or career who is willing to volunteer at least 3 times a year at Sailability events either on or off the water.

Support Adult – £80
An adult who wants to support the charity and take part in Sailability events

Support Family £125
A family of two or more, not supporting a family sailor member, (as defined above) who want to support the charity and take part in Sailability events.

Temporary The first try sailing session is free after which there is a charge of £10 for two further sessions. If you then join Rye Harbour Sailability (RHS) £10 will be deducted from your joining fee. Temporary membership expires after 3 months or after a third try sailing session. After that time if you would still like to sail with Rye Harbour Sailability (RHS) you will need to become a full member.
